# *Yah•Weh Jireh*

**"The Lord Will Provide" (Genesis 22:14)**

**– The name memorialized by  
Abraham when God provided  
the ram to be sacrificed  
in place of Isaac.**

# *Yah•Weh Rapha*

**"The Lord Who Heals" (Exodus 15:26)**

**– "I am Jehovah who heals you" both in body and in soul. In body, by preserving from and curing diseases, and in soul, by pardoning iniquities.**

# *Yah•Weh Nissi*

**"The Lord Our Banner" (Exodus 17:15)**

**– Banner is understood to be a rallying place. This name commemorates the desert victory over the Amalekites in Exodus 17.**

# *Yah•Weh Rohi*

**"The Lord Our Shepherd" (Psalm 23:1)**

**– After David pondered his relationship as a shepherd to his sheep, he realized that was exactly the relationship God had with him, and so he declares, "Yahweh-Rohi is my Shepherd. I shall not want".**

# *Yah•Weh Shalom*

"The Lord Our Peace" (Judges 6:24)

– The name given by Gideon to the altar he built after the Angel of the Lord assured him he would not die as he thought he would after seeing Him.
