Secretary's Report – "Summary"
February 19, 2024

The Board of Administration of King Street Church met on Monday, February 19, 2024 in the Fellowship Room of the main church building. Brad Etchberger, Chairman of the Board of Administration, called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Pastor Steve Flint opened the meeting with devotions and prayer.

Executive Pastor Report
