

Board of Administration  
Secretary's Report – "Summary"  
March 18, 2024

The Board of Administration of King Street Church met on Monday, March 18, 2024 in the Fellowship Room of the main church building. Brad Etchberger, Chairman of the Board of Administration, called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Pastor Steve Flint opened the meeting with devotions and prayer.

KSC Annual Financial Audit

Dave Rotz, Chairperson of the Audit & Compliance Committee, reviewed the KSC Annual Financial Audit results for the 2023 calendar year. Dave reported there were no errors or omissions found during the audit process. Dave commended the Business Manager, Financial Assistant and Treasurer for their work throughout 2023.

Executive Pastor Report

Pastor Steve Flint reported that he has met with the Pastoral Team to discuss visionary ideas. Pastor Steve shared that the Pastoral Team discussed a change in the number of worship services each Sunday morning during the summer months this year.

Finance

Dan Gehris reported on February 2024 and 2024 YTD financial results. Ken Adams reported the Finance Commission met on February 26 and discussed the possibility of offering a class on personal finances, budgeting and/or stewardship.

Local Outreach

Pastor Adam Keath stated that the Local Outreach focus during services on Sunday, March 17 was well received. Pastor Adam also stated that the Adoption Family Support Ministry here at KSC is a very beneficial ministry.

Missions

Don MacAskill shared that the Missions Commission approved a financial gift to Regent Collage in Jamaica to help meet needs there. There were 7 additional school children sponsored in Haiti through KSC. This makes a total of approximately 85 children sponsored by KSC in Haiti.

Children's Ministry

Alexander Rosenbaum shared this year's Vacation Bible School theme is Breaker Rock Beach and VBS will be held from June 23-26 this year. There is still a need for volunteers and teachers to assist with VBS this year. Children's Ministry also has a need for additional Sunday School teachers each week.

Worship Arts

Carolyn Chenaille reported the Adult Choir went to Paramount Nursing Home to sing for the residents. The Worship Arts Commission discussed plans for worship over the summer. The Bell Choir is growing. There is a need for more musicians/drummers.

Adult Ministries

Bryan Bender reported there will be a new Sunday School class at 11:00am.

Student Ministry

Nathan Rosenberger reported that Ashley Gunkelman and Reed Myers have led discussions with the students. We have had as many as 173 students attending Wednesday night meetings. 23 students will be going on a mission trip to Rhode Island this summer.
