

Board of Administration
Secretary's Report – "Summary"
May 20, 2024

The Board of Administration of King Street Church met on Monday, May 20, 2024 in the Fellowship Room of the Baker Center. Brad Etchberger, Chairman of the Board of Administration, called the meeting to order at 7:00pm. Pastor Steve Flint opened the meeting with devotions and prayer.

Executive Pastor Report

Pastor Steve Flint reported that John 17 will be the next sermon series during the month of June. Pastor Steve reminded the Board of the change to the worship service schedule on Sunday mornings starting May 26 for the summer months. Pastor Steve shared that he was also very grateful for the response to our Outdoor Service which was held on Sunday, May 19.

Greg West shared that the elders and pastors met in April. The new elders were introduced to the pastors at this time.

Finance
