# PSALM 122

- <sup>1</sup> I rejoiced with those who said to me, “Let us go to the house of the Lord.”
- <sup>2</sup> Our feet are standing in your gates, Jerusalem.
- <sup>3</sup> Jerusalem is built like a city that is closely compacted together.
- <sup>4</sup> That is where the tribes go up—the tribes of the Lord—to praise the name of the Lord according to the statute given to Israel.
- <sup>5</sup> There stand the thrones for judgment, the thrones of the house of David.

## PSALM 122 *(continued)*

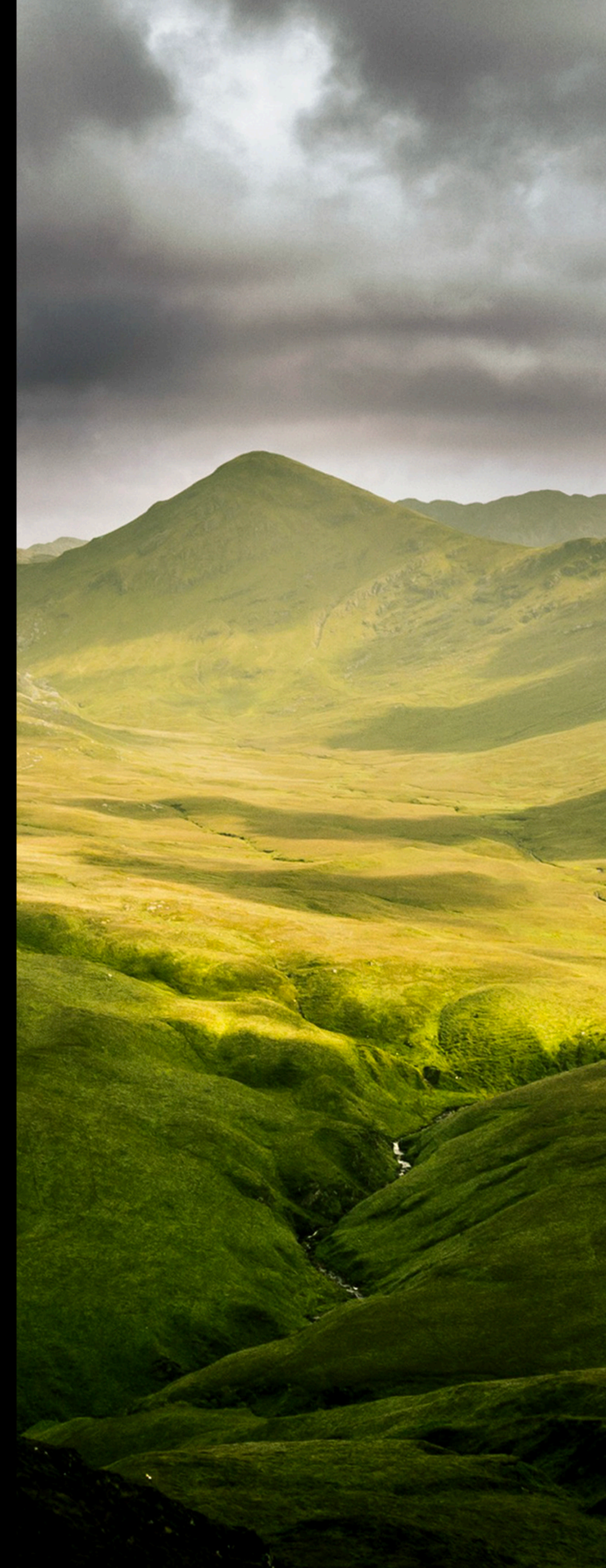
<sup>6</sup> Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: “May those who love you be secure.

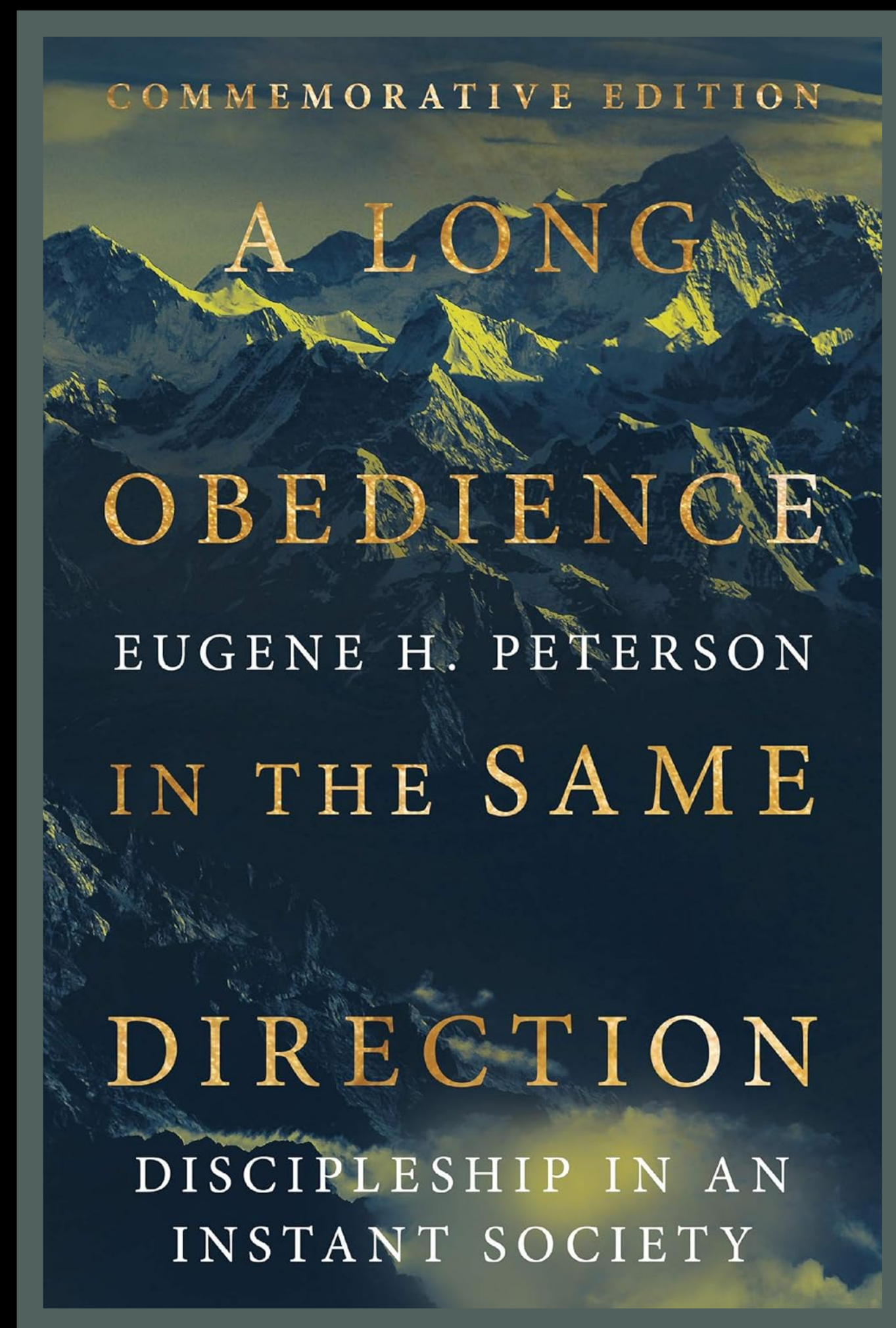
<sup>7</sup> May there be peace within your walls and security within your citadels.”
