HANDS ON

Word of Wonder Telephone

Our Word of Wonder for the God with Us series is Hebrews 13:5b. It teaches us the wonderful truth that God never leaves us alone, no matter what. He has said so Himself!

Play a simple game of telephone to help the whole family learn the Word of Wonder. Invite everyone to sit in a circle. Choose someone to start by whispering the verse into the ear of the person sitting next to her. That person can then whisper what he heard to the person next to him. Continue around until you reach the last person, who can then say the verse out loud. If a few of the words are wrong, read or say it aloud so everyone knows the correct wording. Play a few times until the Word of Wonder is memorized!
