KSC Annual Financial Audit

Dave Rotz presented the results of the KSC Annual Financial Audit. The audit went extremely well again this year with absolutely no errors found. Dave shared his appreciation to the Audit Team for their service and Dan Gehris shared his appreciation for Andrea Hartman and her excellent work as our Financial Assistant.
