Secretary's Report – "Summary"

December 15, 2025

The Board of Administration of King Street Church met on Monday, December 15, 2025 in Room B201.

Senior Pastor Report

Senior Pastor Aaron Perry reported on his work narrative for June 1 through December 15, 2025. Pastor Aaron reported that he preached 23 sermons, is working on building relationships and showing his personal commitment to King Street Church. He, as well as his family, are glad God called them to King Street Church.

Executive Pastor Report

Pastor Steve reported the staff annual review process is underway. Managers have been provided highly effective tools to help their direct reports thrive in performance and growth, and in ministry fulfillment and competency.

Elder Report

Tom Knepper reported that the LOC had their quarterly meeting with 13 ministry partners in attendance. Pastor Steve reported that the LOC worked with Pastor Rob Gunkelman on Thanksgiving meals. We had 1,131 boxes of food packed. Approximately 2,200 items were donated to various schools. RESET celebrated their annual Thanksgiving Dinner and also hosted the Light the Night event.

Student Ministry

Student Ministry held special events recently like rock climbing, ice skating and Christmas Party celebrations for the students. Pastor Rob and Lauren Zook are grateful for these relational building events with students and friends.

Missions

We had a visit from Willie Mpasuka, the director of Rays of Hope. The Missions Team is also focused on arranging year-end gifts that will be sent to our partners and missions' families to help them finish this year in a strong position.

Worship Arts
