## FAMILY CONVERSATIONS

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- We all have different skills and talents. What skills and talents are you grateful for?

- What are your favorite ways to express creativity? Where do you think we get our creativity?



## CREATE IT!

### Family Handprint Tree

Gather a posterboard and some markers or paints. **Each of us is “fearfully and wonderfully made” by a loving, creative God. This also means that our family is “fearfully and wonderfully made”—we are one of a kind and no other family is exactly like ours! Let’s create a work of art together to remember we are made on purpose, for a purpose.**

At the top of the paper write “The (insert your family’s last name) family is fearfully and wonderfully made!” Trace or paint each person’s handprint (in his or her favorite color!) around the top half and sides of the poster. Draw or paint a tree trunk from the bottom of the poster up, with branches reaching to the handprints. Encourage each person to color in and sign his name inside his handprint. Read Psalm 139 together. Then place your Family Handprint Tree somewhere visible and remind one another that you are fearfully and wonderfully made by God!



## WALK IT ACT IT MOVE IT

### Where is God? Scavenger Hunt

The writer of Psalm 139 describes all kinds of places he can’t escape God’s presence. God is everywhere, and God promises to care for and guide us wherever we go too. God made us on purpose, for a purpose. Follow the directions on this scavenger hunt to find God in your own home! Read Psalm 139:5–11 then do the scavenger hunt. End with a prayer together to thank God for being with you.

- Go to the highest spot in your home. When you get there, say, “God is here!”
- Go to the lowest spot in your home. When you get there, say, “God is here!”
- Go to the eastern-most spot in your home. When you get there, say, “God is here!”
- Go to the western-most spot in your home. When you get there, say, “God is here!”
- Go to the darkest spot in your home. When you get there, say, “God is here!”
