Meeting Minutes **Summary** for **April 20, 2026**

Senior Pastor Report

Pastor Aaron has received his provisional UBiC license. It will automatically transfer to a full license after one year. Pastor Aaron expressed his pride in the ministry and operational teams, especially Pastor Nathan, for successfully adding a 5th Easter service. Special thanks to Pastor Steve for his work with the Maundy Thursday service.

Executive Pastor Report

Pastor Steve expressed his gratitude for Pastor Becky and the Children's Ministry team, for their hard work and dedication. There were three baptisms on April 26 and six child dedications on May 17. Pastor Steve recognized Pastor Nathan and the Worship Arts team for their hard work on the Good Friday service prerecorded broadcast and the Kids Choir volunteers for their faithful service. The staff have started the ROCK implementation by entering the discovery phase with Divine Technology Services (DTS).

Business Manager Report

Dan Gehris presented the March 2026 financial summary. Dan shared that March undesignated giving of \$298k was over budget by \$32k, and year-to-date over by \$29k. March total operating income was just over \$300k. Income is currently increasing each month. March expenses of \$212k were under budget by \$11k, and year-to-date under by \$51k. Result is a net gain of \$88k for March (\$94k with subsidy) and \$72k year-to-date (\$79k with subsidy). Cash balance at the end of March was \$888k.

Local Outreach Report

Tom Knepper shared that the next LOC quarterly meeting will be held Tuesday, May 5th at 7pm. LOC recently met with Pastor Jay Brown and made a donation to support Jay's new ministry. Tom shared that She's Somebody's Daughter is teaming up with another similar ministry that focuses on teaching.

Director of Discipleship

Brian Mace circulated a partial draft of the current Director of Discipleship position description for Board consideration. Plan is to add the qualifications and circulate the final draft to the Board for email vote prior to the May meeting. PRC also still needs to approve. **Update:** PRC approved the revised Director of Discipleship position description via email vote on April 26th. The Board of Administration unanimously approved via email vote on April 29th.
